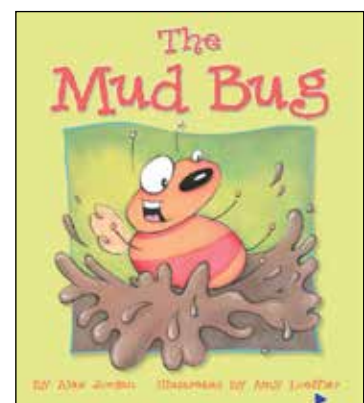
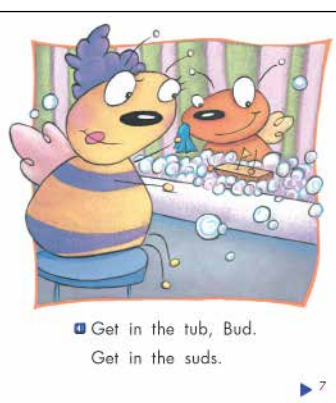
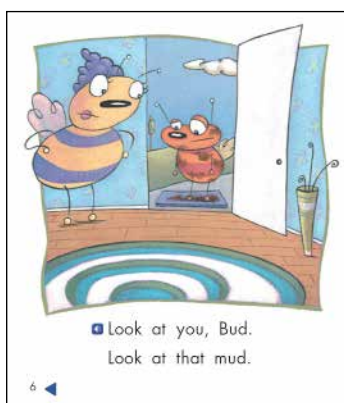
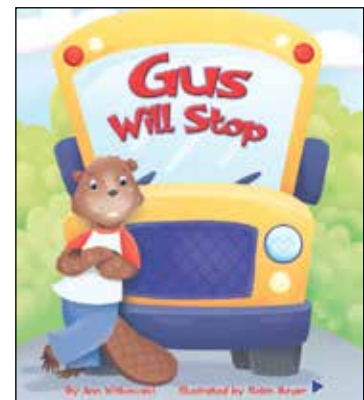
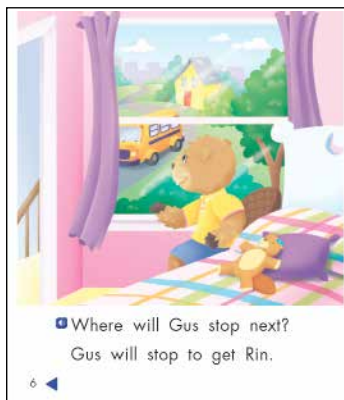
Reading Street begins with a collection of readers that help kindergarten children acquire the complex skills of emergent literacy.

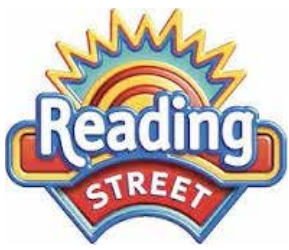
Kindergarten Student Readers

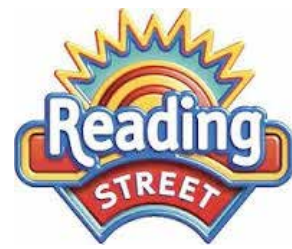
Independent Readers

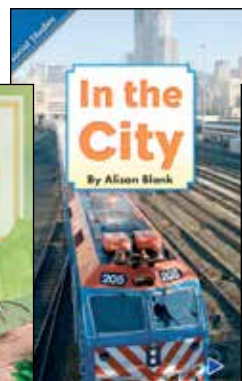
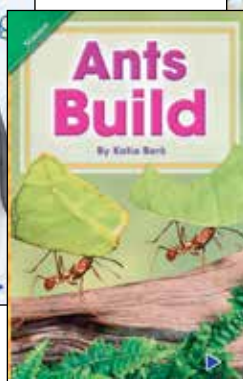
The Concept literacy Readers are 36 non fiction books designed to help below level readers better understand basic concepts and themes.
